The experience of being deaf is often misunderstood. British Sign Language (BSL) users are part of a cultural and linguistic minority; proud of their language and heritage. On the other hand, hard of hearing or deafened people often have a very different experience. However, regardless of a person's level of hearing loss, what many do not understand is just how isolating deafness can be. Most people will assume it is simply about not being able to hear but, in fact, deafness can be about the daily struggles a person has with communication and the huge impact it can have on a person's mental and physical wellbeing.

GDA is here to provide practical and emotional support that enables a person to live confidently with their deafness.

GDA also works in partnership with local groups such as Gloucester Deaf Club (GDC) to further support our local deaf community.
